



## **The CCC is awarding grants for translational oncological research projects**

**The CCC is currently tendering research grants for interdisciplinary translational research projects from the field of malignant diseases, which must be carried out at the Medical University of Vienna. A major goal of the CCC is the development of interdisciplinary translational cancer research. The success of the 'Cancer Research Initiative' has made it possible for the CCC to tender funds for supporting interdisciplinary translational research projects. Disbursements of up to €60,000 per research projects will be paid out. A seven-person jury, accompanied by international experts, will review and assess the projects submitted for their content, quality, originality and success potential.

### **How to apply**

Please submit the following documents with your application:

1. Description of the current scientific situation with regards to your area of interest
2. Description of the project, with a maximum of three pages. In particular, you must take into account the originality of your project, and describe the current focus and / or focus for developments of your organisational unit and research group in your area of interest
3. Description of the methods you will use to achieve the aim of your project
4. Collaborations
5. Finance plan, taking into account the above financial framework, and description of the prospect of applying for further third party funds to fund your project.
